## **Appellate**

## Representative Matters

<u>Link Motion Inc. v. DLA Piper LLP, 103 F.4th 905, 907 (2d Cir. 2024)</u>:The Second Circuit vacated the district court's dismissal of a legal malpractice action for lack of federal jurisdiction and remanded the case to state court.

<u>Lee v. Leifer, 209 A.D.3d 531, 532 (N.Y. App. Div. 1st Dep't 2022)</u>: The appellate court affirmed the denial of the defendants' motion to dismiss a legal malpractice complaint.
